Originally developed by Carl Orff and Gunild Keetman, the Orff-Schulwerk (school work), is a process that combines music skills. Sing, say, dance, play, improvise, listen, create, and compose to raise students’ musicianship, while educating the total child in a fun and natural way. **Who?** All music teachers can benefit from Orff workshops. Whether you have completed Orff levels or are a beginning teacher, these workshops demonstrate a learning process. Come celebrate the art of teaching music! **What?** Membership in SFOC costs \$55 for the year, including 5 local workshops, plus the State workshop in February near Orlando, OR you may pay \$30 as you go to each workshop.
