Orff Schulwerk Level I is the first of three courses toward receiving American Orff Schulwerk Association (AOSA) Certification. Teachers of Orff Schulwerk become dancers, singers, and instrumentalists, finding artistic expression in unfamiliar instruments and find new ways to express artistic ideas with their bodies and voices. The daily schedule will be divided up among Pedagogy / Basic Orff, as well as Recorder and Movement. Each day will conclude with Special Topics.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

All course fees are payable to SFOC (South Florida Orff Chapter). Early registration fee is \$700. Registration fee after 6/1/18 is \$750. (See attached registration form for details.) If you pay by check, you may reduce the total registration amount by \$5.00 (\$695 on or before 6/1/18, \$745 after 6/1/18).

CANCELLATION POLICY

Registrations cancelled before 5/1/18 may receive a full refund. Registrations cancelled between 5/1/18 and 6/1/18 will be accepted minus a \$100 cancellation fee. Any registrations cancelled after June 1, 2018 are non-refundable. If registrations fall below the minimum number required to hold the class, SFOC reserves the right to cancel the program and all fees will be refunded.

GRADUATE CREDIT

Students who want to earn graduate credit must first register with SFOC and make full payment. In order to be applied towards your masters degree in Music Education from Florida International University in Miami, participants must apply to the Graduate School and the School of Music by 3/1/18. The application deadline for non-degree seeking students is 6/22/18. All students must register for the course through the University by 6/25/18. Costs per credit hour is \$455.64 for Florida residents and \$1,001.69 for non-Florida residents. If you have any questions, please contact Dr. Sandra Sanchez Adorno, Asst. Professor of Music Education at sadorno@fiu.edu. Current FIU students and those seeking to earn graduate credit will be offered a \$300 discount on the SFOC fee.

MATERIALS

The required materials may be purchased on the first day of classes from West Music, or purchased in advance on your own. All students will need a soprano recorder (preferably the Yamaha 302B). The two required books are *Music for Children*, Murray Edition, Volume I and *Recorder Routes I*, revised by Carol King.

They have presented at the AOSA Professional Development Conferences, as well as local chapters throughout Florida. Liese Connell is the Course Director, assisted by Claudia Lusararian, SFOC President. They have both represented the South Florida Orff Chapter for Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach County music teachers since 2004.
